## **FAAC POSTMORTEM SUB-COMMITTEE**

# UPDATE ON THE WITHDRAWALS FROM THE OIL AND NON-OIL EXCESS REVENUE ACCOUNT (SAVINGS) FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 2020 TO DECEMBER, 2023

#### 1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 Members may recall that at the FAAC Plenary meeting held in September 2023, members observed the arbitral deductions from the Non-Oil Excess Revenue Account savings by the Federal Government specifically the huge amounts being borrowed as loan. Furthermore, the representatives of the Oil Producing States requested to know if 13% derivation was deducted from the amount being transferred as savings to the Non-Oil Excess Revenue Account. After extensive deliberation, FAAC Plenary referred the issue to the FAAC Postmortem Sub-Committee to examine and report back.
- 1.2 Accordingly, the Sub-Committee commenced the assignment by examining the Non-Oil Excess Revenue Account Ledger and also wrote the Office of the Accountant-General of the Federation (OAGF) to provide some information in respect of the subject. The analysis of the documents are summarized as follows:

### 2.0 INFLOW INTO THE OIL EXCESS REVENUE ACCOUNT

2.1 The sum of N119,567,990,026.62 was the total amount paid into the Oil Excess Revenue Account for the period January, 2015 to December, 2023. This amount was made up of an opening balance of N67,990,026.62 and March, 2020 receipt of N119,500,000,000.00. The 13% Derivation of N119,500,000,000.00 amounting to N15,535,000,000.00 was distributed to the Oil Producing States in April, 2023 while the balance of N103,965,000,000.00 was shared to the three tiers of government in the month of May, 2020. The balance in the Oil Excess Revenue Account as December 2023 was N67,990,026.62. Details are shown in table 1 below:

## 4.0 OUTFLOW FROM THE NON-OIL EXCESS REVEUE ACCOUNT

4.1 Out of the total inflow of **N2,807,067,427,659.48** for the period under review, the sum of **N1,095,298,000,000.00** was distributed to the three tiers of Government

while the sum of **N1,489,338,148,240.92** represented deductions for other purposes. Details of these deductions are contained in Tables 3, and 4 below:

The amount distributed to the three tiers of Government was **N1,095,298,000,000.00**.

# 4.0 SUMMARY OF INFLOW AND OUTFLOW FROM THE NON-OIL EXCESS ACCOUNT

4.1 The total amount that accrued into the Non-Oil Excess Revenue Account was N2,807,067,427,659.48, distribution to the three tiers of Government was N1,095,298,000,000.00, other releases was N1,489,338,148,240.92 leaving a net balance of N222,431,279,418.56 as at the end of December, 2023 as shown in table 5 below:

#### 5.0 Findings:

- **5.1** From the Analysis of Oil and Non-Oil Excess Revenue Accounts, the Sub-Committee observed the following:
  - That the sum of N119,567,990,026.62 accrued into the Oil Excess Revenue Account in the period under review;
- ii. That the sum of **N119,500,000,000.00** was distributed to the three tiers of government leaving a net balance of **N67,990,026.62** in the Oil Excess Revenue account as at the end of October, 2023;
- iii. That the total inflow into the Non-oil Excess Account for the period January 2020 to December 2023 was **N2,807,067,427,659.48**;
- iv. That the total amount distributed to the three tiers of Government was the sum of
  v. Total deductions from the period under review;
- v. Total deductions from the Account for other purposes amounted to **N1,489,338,148,240.92** in the period under review;
- vi. That the sum of **N20,009,001,423.57** was deducted as Refund of Gas Flared penalty to NMDPRA;
- vii. That the sum of **N20 billion** was transferred to the 20% of Amount due to States on ECA withdrawals Account;
- viii. That the sum of **N143,750,773,205.86** was used for Refund of PAYE to States and the sum of **N31,311,515,329.52** for FCT respectively;
- ix. That FGN borrowed the sum of N41,844,164,400.00 for the payment of final Settlement of Ground Rent Liabilities;
  x. That FGN borrowed the sum of N227 constant
- x. That FGN borrowed the sum of **N227,998,501,190.36** for the funding of 2023 General Elections;
- xi. That amount borrowed by FGN for Payment of Contingencies to the Office of the National Security Adviser was **N2,750,000,000.00**;
- That the sum **N28,608,118,834.81** was deducted from the Account to Refund xiii. That the difference between 5
- xiii. That the difference between Foreign taxes figures on Component Statement and Actual was deducted from the Non-Oil Account to the tune of N73,066,073,856.80;
- xiv. The sum of N30,000,000,000.00 was deducted from the Account for refund to CISS being amount borrowed for FIRS's Priority Projects:
- xv. That there was no record that the amounts borrowed by FGN was paid back;

### 6.0 Recommendations:

- 6.1 The Sub-Committee recommends as follows:
  - a) that the sum of N1,489,338,148,240.92 deductions for other purposes should be refunded back to the account;

b) that further deductions from the account should be in line with the Vertical Revenue Allocation Formular.
