On behalf of the Comptroller-General of Customs, it is my pleasure presenting to you this report on revenue collected by the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) for the month of **JULY**, **2021**.

 NDCC (Negotiable Duty Credit Certificate) which is non cash receipt for JANUARY to JULY, 2021 is NIL.

The collection of \$109,917,826,944.35 in the month of JULY, 2021 accounts for 104.08% of the 2021 provisional monthly budget of \$105,612,467,641.58 (Appendix "A"). This is lower than JUNE, 2021 collection of \$112,429,552,475.09 by \$2,511,725,530.74 or 2.23%. This is attributable to a decrease in the volume of imports and excise duty in the month under review relative to the preceding month.
