2. The collections are grouped into: Royalty from Minerals (used and sold), Fees, majorly from (i) Annual Service Fee (ii) Registration and Issuance of Mining License etc. as indicated in the table attached:

2. Note:

The Revenue collection by MMSD into the Federation Account for the month of **January 2024** is **N945,436,131.53** The Ministry recorded a negative variance in the collection from Royalty for the month by **N1,071,821,431.93** when compared with the previous month.

Furthermore, there was a positive variance in the month of **January**, **2024** for Fee collection, from Mining Cadastral Office (**MCO**) when compared with the previous month by **N2,155,500.00** the positive variance is attributable of the following:

- The positive variance recorded in Fee collection is attributable to the large turnout for renewal of Mining Licenses within the period under review.
- Payment of Annual service fee by licensed Mining operators contributed to the positive variance recorded in the month of January, 2024.
- It is worthy to note that collections from fees are expected to experience an upward growth owing to the current number of applications for Mining licenses received, if all is granted.
- The Ministry however did not meet up with the monthly target. There is
 a negative variance of -N37,867,505.29 when you compare the
 month's (January) collection against the monthly target. This can be
 attributed to low mining activities owing to late return of most operators
 to the sites.


