REPORT OF THE REVENUE COLLECTED BY THE NIGERIA CUSTOMS SERVICE TO FEDERATION ACCOUNTS ALLOCATION COMMITTEE (FAAC) MEETING VIA VIRTUAL CONFERENCING HOLDING ON 16TH AND 17TH SEPTEMBER, 2021

On behalf of the Comptroller-General of Customs, it is my pleasure presenting to you this report on revenue collected by the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) for the month of **AUGUST**, **2021**.

The Service collected the sum of ¥116,873,746,667.27 as detailed below:-

NOTE:

 NDCC (Negotiable Duty Credit Certificate) which is non cash receipt for JANUARY to AUGUST, 2021 is NIL.

The collection of \$116,873,746,667.27 in the month of AUGUST, 2021 accounts for 110.66% of the 2021 provisional monthly budget of \$105,612,467,641.58 (Appendix "A"). This is higher than JULY, 2021 collection of \$109,917,826,944.35 by \$6,955,919,722.92 or 6.33%. This is attributable to a increase in the volume of imports in the month under review relative to the preceding month.

The transfer to the Federation Account by the CBN for the month amounted to \$151,739,745,112.24 (see Appendix "B"),consisting of \$39,037,855,938.80 reconciled figure wrongly transferred to 65% Wheat Levy moved to Import duty (Federation Account). The charges deducted by the designated banks was \$35,062,124.00 as can be seen in the reconciliation statement of collection and transfer to Federation Account, (Appendix "C") and FAAC revenue reporting format (Appendix "D") respectively.
